Thank you for the Freedom of Information request you have made. I can confirm that the information requested is held by Birmingham Children's Trust. I have detailed below the information that is being released to you.

### **Request**

**I recently contacted the Trust for information relating to the use of unregulated accommodation.**

**I asked for the number of children placed in unregulated accommodation by the Trust. I asked the Trust to provide the figures for the following calendar years: 2023 and 2022. The Trust provided a response.**

**As a follow up to my initial request, I wondered whether the FOI team could provide the figures for the calendar year 2024 please.**

### **Response**

For the calendar year 2024 the Trust have placed 28 children under 16 in unregistered settings.
