The majority of placements are made via frameworks. There are regional frameworks in operation between 14 Local Authorities for both Supported Accommodation and Residential - the West Midlands Regional Supported Accommodation Framework and the West Midlands Residential Framework

For Supported Accommodation the lead is Staffordshire and this framework is closed until 2027 when it will be recommissioned. The contact email address is: Supported.accommodation@Staffordshire.gov.uk
